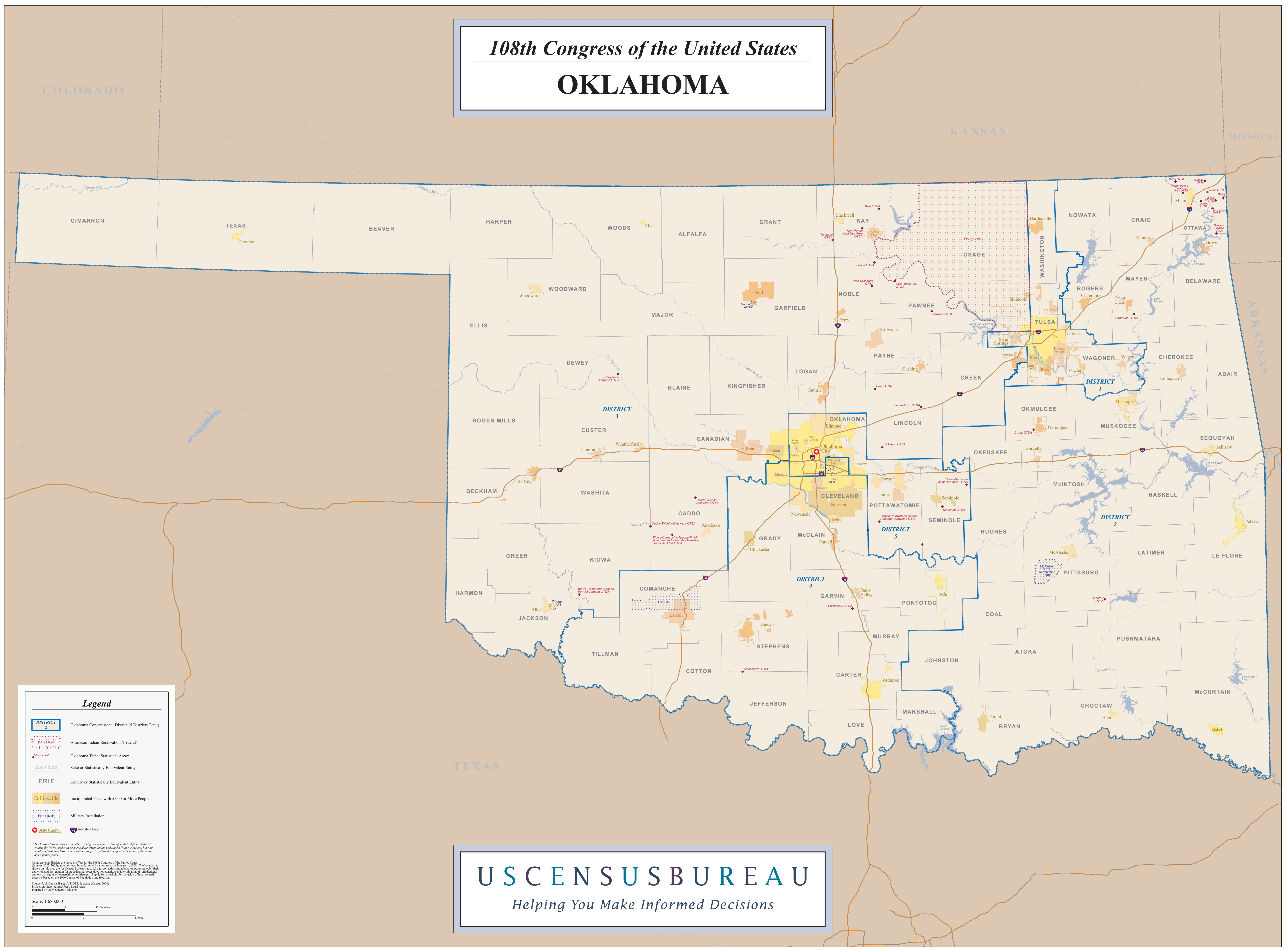


# 108th Congress of the United States OKLAHOMA
